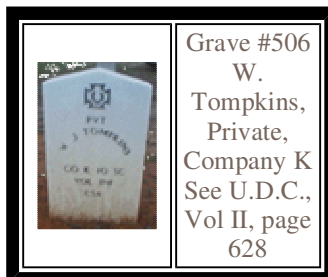

It appears that the recorded Grave #506 has been changed to reflect a member of the Tenth South Carolina with the same name on the new stone. This is not correct according to the records I have seen. 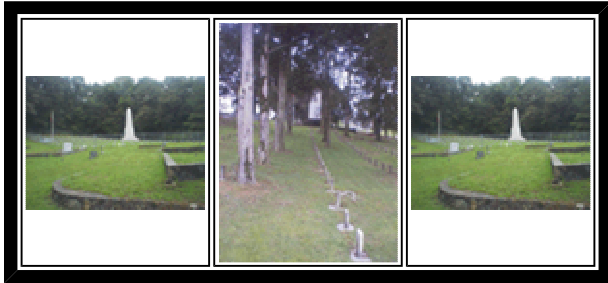
